TOURNAMENT REGULATIONS (to be retained)

- All matches in the main draw will be the best of 3 games to 15 points using WCPP sandpaper bats.
- 2. All matches will have a sudden death point if the match goes to 14 all to decide the set.
- 3. A double point ball can be played once during each match by each player. Each player can choose to play their double point ball at any time on their service when their score is 12 points or less.
- 4. The main colour of clothing must not be white or orange.
- 5. Non scottish players that do not permanently reside in Scotland are eligible to play. However, after the initial group, they will not be eligible for the main knockout stage, only the plate event.
- 6. No competitor or official shall engage in betting on players or matches.
- 7. All competitors will be required to umpire.
- 8. All competitors must report to the top table on arrival.
- 9. The referee's decision shall be final on a point of law and on any question arising not provided for in these regulations, or in any dispute as to the interpretation thereof.
- 10. The event will be seeded based on the Ratings Central <u>Sandpaper Ratings</u> and <u>Table</u> <u>Tennis Ratings</u>, with adjustments made based on opinion of tournament committee.
- 11. When dealing with unrated players, we will try to balance groups based on a prediction of their standards.
- 12. Players from the same club will be seperated in groups where possible.

TOURNAMENT INFORMATION

- If it becomes necessary to restrict entries, this will be on the basis of last received first out.
- The competition format is subject to change dependent on the number of entries.
- 3. Payment should be completed with the entry. Those paying on the day will be subject to a £3 surcharge.
